

HORSE SHOW OFFICE HOURS

The office will be open Thursday, October 3rd, 2019 for additional entries from 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM. The office will open at 9:00 AM on Friday, October 4th, 2019. The office will close one hour prior to each performance.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE Arrival Thursday, October 3rd (*Not before 10:00 AM*) Departure Sunday October 6th.

Early arrival or late departure will be charged a **\$20.00** a day fee per stall. Please contact a member of the stabling committee to make these arrangements. Special circumstance will be the only requests considered.

STABLING

Excellent permanent box stalls are available. All stalls have doors. All stabling must be made and paid with entries IN ADAVANCE by mail. No telephone reservations will be accepted. No reservations will be accepted until premium books are mailed. This is to ensure that everyone receives the same opportunity to reserve stalls. Stalls will be assigned in the order in which deposits are received.

Stall occupancy will be \$110 for the entire show and tack stalls will also be \$110 for the entire show. All horses on the grounds must rent a stall. Make checks payable to MSHA.

BEDDING

All shavings used on the grounds must be purchased through Minnesota Equestrian Center with your entry form. Pre-purchased shavings will be delivered to your stall for \$8.00 per bag. A minimum of 2 bags must be purchased per horse stall. During the show, bedding orders may be placed in the show office. No straw is allowed as bedding.

CAMPING

Camper Hook-Ups are available at the Minnesota Equestrian Center. They are designated on a first come basis at \$75.00 per spot, sign up on the entry form for your camper hook up. You must come into the Horse Show Office to pickup a registration sticker to be placed on the windshield or door of your camper. There are plenty of hook ups throughout the grounds.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE MINNESOTA EQUESTRIAN CENTER ARENA AND GROUNDS

All posted parking and traffic restrictions will be in full force.

No cats are allowed, and all dogs must be on a leash. Obey the NO SMOKING restrictions.

All manure from daily cleaning must be put in the designated areas. Shavings are not allowed in the barn aisles.

SHOW ARENA AND WARM UP AREA

The show arena is 100' x 210' and the footing consists of dirt and sand. There is an 80' x 130' indoor warm up area, the footing consists of sand.

STABLING FACILITIES MAY NOT BE ALTERED

The use of nails or staples on the stalls or woodwork is not acceptable. A \$50.00 charge will be applied to your entry form if found used. Please comply with this rule. Thank you for your consideration.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE OPERATION - Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to: golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6.

Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Entries close September 23rd, 2019 Post entries, except Classics, will be accepted after September 23rd, 2019 but will be charged a post entry of \$25.00 per horse. All post entries must be made at least one hour before the start of each performance. Horses that have been entered by September 23rd, 2019 may enter additional classes without the Post Entry Fee

All entry and stall fees must accompany the entry form and all charge accounts (this includes individual post entries) must be accompanied by a signed check and be made out to MSHA. Cost of all pre-ordered shavings will be included with this check. All registered horses must have a copy of their registration papers with the entry form. No numbers will be issued until this requirement is met. NO EXCEPTIONS!

The complete **name and address of the owner** of record must appear in the space on the entry form entitled owner. Only one owner can appear on each entry for. Please send entries to:

\$25 charge for incomplete entries. Entries not containing all necessary documents to verify eligibility for horse/rider/owner/

/trainer/handler (including negative Coggins) will be considered incomplete. Copies of registration papers showing proof of current ownership, copies of current USEF, ASHA, UPHA, AHHS membership (as applicable) and current negative Coggins must accompany the entry blanks along with REQUIRED three (3) signatures and complete addresses for owner and trainer.

A \$25 fee will be charged for all returned checks, and if returned checks have not been replaced within 2 weeks after notification, USEF will be notified.

Exhibitors canceling their entries after September 24th, 2019 shall forfeit their entry and stabling fees. During the course of the show, entry fees may be refunded only if the horse scratched is examined by the Official Show Veterinarian and certified unable to show.

No stall or office fees will be refunded.

Note: Entries will not be accepted nor numbers issued without proper signatures, membership information or registration paper presented. All registered horses must submit a copy of their registration papers and **Coggins test with their entry forms.**

Failure to scratch: A \$100 fine will be levied for failure to scratch an entry at least **one hour before** the performance is scheduled to start from a class that is subsequently divided.

Stake/Championship Entries: To be eligible for entry in a **Stake** or **Championship** Class, a horse or pony must have been properly entered, shown and judged in the line-up in a qualifying class for that **Stake** or **Championship.** All Stake and Championship entries must be declared and paid for in the show office before the horse is allowed to show. This applies to stables with open checks.

To Be Announced Classes: Class numbers 14 and 66 have been left in the schedule to add requested classes. Classes can be requested by contacting the show manager and offering to sponsor the class for \$60.00 Added classes will be posted in the show office, will appear on the website at www.msha.org and emails will be sent out to the exhibitors. DIVISION OF CLASSES

Driving classes will be divided at 10. Prize money will be doubled and separate trophies and ribbons distributed for divided classes. Notification of intent to divide a class will be made one hour prior to the class.

LIMIT CLASSES

Limit Rider/Driver not to have won six blue ribbons in any under Saddle or Driving classes.

Limit Horse classes not to have won six blue ribbons in any under Saddle classes if competing in an under Saddle class or not have won six blue ribbons in any Driving classes if competing in a driving class.

MINNESOTA HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All horses on the grounds must be in good health. Animals showing evidence of contagious or infectious diseases will be removed from the grounds by order of the official veterinarian. Horses originating from outside Minnesota must be accompanied by an Interstate Health Certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian within thirty (30) days prior to the exhibition identifying each horse and certifying that it is free, insofar as can be determined, from infectious disease. A negative Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia within six (12) months and proof of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccination within (6) months of entering the stable or fairgrounds must accompany each horse. These documents must be recorded by the office personnel for each horse brought onto the fairgrounds.

All horses must have a current 2019 negative Coggins test; this includes all Weanlings that are attending the show. Exempt from Coggins requirement are Weanlings at the side of the mare, however Coggins for the mare are required.

An official veterinarian will be designated to make official inspections and ruling in all cases where the opinion of a veterinarian is required. No one shall approach a veterinarian with regard to his decision unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee or Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the veterinarian at the proper time and place. Medical Waste: Competition management shall place at least one sharps container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharps instruments in convenient locations in barns housing show horses. It is competition management's responsibility to replace such containers when full and dispose of them properly. Competition management may fine any individual(s) including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

CONTACT WITH JUDGE

No exhibitor will be permitted to confer with a judge unless he or she is accompanied by the show steward.

RULES OF THE MINNESOTA FUTURITY SHOW

The Minnesota Saddlebred Horse Association (MSHA) will not be responsible for any damages to persons, animals or property at the show, nor shall they be liable for any accidents or injuries sustained by persons or animals on the show grounds at any time. Neither will they be responsible for any vehicle or any equipment, which is lost or damaged.

The Show Committee reserves the right to make such changes in procedure, personnel, rules and regulations as shall be deemed by them to be in the best interest of the show.

Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to judges and/or officials on the part of the Exhibitor shall forfeit his entry, stall fees and prize money. The Horse Show Committee shall have the power to bar an offender from further competition and remove him and his entire exhibit from the grounds. The Horse Show shall not be held liable for damages of any kind as a result of such action and this shall be accepted as conditions of entry.

RULES GOVERNING THE SHOWING OF ALL WEANLINGS AND YEARLINGS

The use of artificial appliances or devices on Weanlings or Yearlings such as, but not limited to, chains, shackles, rubber bands, blindfolds or full cup blinkers is prohibited on the grounds before or during the show. Smooth, round leather straps will be allowed on the grounds before the class. Blinker hoods with half cups mounted in the vertical position so as to allow forward vision are allowed to be used before the class. The use of a curb bit is prohibited.

Weanlings and Yearlings must show with uncut, unset tails tail sets worn on the show grounds or in preparation for the show are expressly forbidden. Bustles are permitted on Yearlings.

MSHA Futurity Classes are open to horses nominated in the Minnesota Saddlebred Horse Futurity and are to be shown in accordance with those rules.

Any entry with prohibited equipment MUST be disqualified from further competition and shall forfeit all entry fees and winnings.

ASB 3-Gaited Classic Pleasure- Saddle Seat Equipment. The Classic Pleasure Horse must exhibit a natural, relaxed manner. Its headset should complement its natural confirmation. Classic Pleasure Horses must be plain shod, rim pads or a single pad (no wedges). The Classic Pleasure horse's walk should be flat-footed and ground covering, but stylish, with light to medium contact. The trot should be four-cornered and fluid, not labored, executed at medium speed. The Classic Pleasure Horse should be able to trot on the rail. The Classic canter should be a true three beat gait ridden with light to medium rein contact, and be straight, correct and organized on both leads. It should give the appearance of a smooth, quiet, collected and comfortable ride with aggressive speed or choppiness to be heavily penalized. At all gaits, the Classic Horse should appear to be suitable for an entry-level rider, regardless of the experience of current rider. To be judged 80% on manners and way of going and 20% on confirmation.
